Rationale:

Kingswood cultivates a teaching and learning environment that is flexible, caring and focused on what is best for the students.

Aim:

To provide a safe learning environment that meets the needs of all students at all levels of their primary school life

Implementation:

The Student Code of Conduct is consistent with the department guidelines and regulations.

PRINCIPLES: The Code of Conduct is based upon the following principles:

- All students have a right to be safe
- All students have the right to work and play without interference
- All students are expected to be polite, courteous and well mannered
- Parents have an obligation to support the school in this Policy
- The Principal and staff have an obligation to implement the Code of Conduct fairly and consistently

BEHAVIOURS: All students are expected to observe the following behaviours:

- We respect our teachers and follow their instructions
- We show consideration towards all people in our school and our community
- We act positively and always encourage others
- We look after our school and other people's property
- We move safely around the school
- We play sensibly in our preferred areas

STRATEGIES: Kingswood Primary School will implement the following strategies to support the Policy:

- Implement Values Program
- Modelling appropriate behaviour
- Setting appropriate and achievable goals
- Rewards for positive and appropriate behaviour
- Encouraging personal excellence
- Promoting cooperative group actions
- Developing independence in learning
- Embedding Habits of Mind into school culture
